Silken Ciudad Gijón Hotel

Silken Ciudad Gijón is a four stars hotel located in a modern architecture building rising up in the city of Gijón, 500 m far from one of its 3 beaches and from the sport port. The hotel has café, restaurant, modular meeting rooms with a combined capacity for 1,200 people, business centre, executive storey, wellness centre, equipped with a gym, saunas and heated pools, a garage and a spacious terrace.





It is situated in a strategic location enables quick and easy access from Asturias Airport, 36 Km away. Likewise, it is near the bus and railway stations (the latter just 100 metres from the hotel).

FUNDOMA

Fundoma is a huge complex 10 minutes far by feet from Oviedo city center and its train and bus station. Its main facilities are:

- ✓ Free laundry.
- ✓ Sport center.
- ✓ Tennis, football and basketball court.

All rooms of the complex are double rooms. Each building is divided in apartments without kitchen. Each apartment has 2 double rooms and a bathroom, so 4 people are hosted in an apartment and share 1 bathroom.





Double room – Full board: 25 €/person*

This accommodation option does not include cleaning service inside of the rooms, only in the common areas and bathrooms.

Towels and sheets are changed weekly.

Double room – Full board with daily cleaning service: 28 €/person*

ANNEX: BEST TRAVEL POSSIBILITIES TO COME TO ASTURIAS

Asturias airport has different low cost airlines which connect our region to Barcelona, Madrid, London and Venice.

➤ MADRID

Madrid is connected with Asturias by bus, train and plane. Although prices are very dynamic and may vary a lot depending on the demand, they are normally:

Bus (<https://www.alsa.es/en/home>): **80 €** go and return.

Train (<http://www.renfe.com/EN/viajeros/index.html>): **80 €** go and return.

Plane (<https://www.iberiaexpress.com/en>): **100 €** go and return.

➤ BARCELONA

Barcelona is connected with Asturias by plane. Although prices are very dynamic and may vary a lot depending on the demand, they are normally:
