# About the Association

Our association was founded in 2001 with the aim to support Youth Associations with financial, professional and juristical background, as well as taking the role on the field of youth policy. The target group of the Youth Centre Association are people aged between 10 and 30. Those people who would like to do something for their community we provide space and opportunity to become part of the society.

Those working in our association accept the common value as openness, creativity and trust towards each other. In our community we realize these values through help, support and team work. We provide support for informal youth groups in the framework of the Association.

We hope that our goals empower young people and help to create a network of volunteers in the region. Those young people who get in touch with us can have such experiences that are major factors in their future lives.





Currently our Association operates four offices in different cities: Debrecen, Nyíregyháza, Szolnok and in Karcag.

We actively take part in the youth policy of the region, and continuously take part in partnerships with several youth governments, NGO's,, elementary- and high schools.

Since 2010 we have hosted more than 100 volunteers from Poland, Spain, Italy, Germany, Latvia, Georgia, Romania, Serbia, Russia, Turkey, Finland, Norway, France, Estonia and Belgium.

During the project, volunteers will get an opportunity to improve the local youth community.

# *Project description*

The name of the project is Volunteering 4 All, which symbolizes the volunteers from different countries working together with Hungarian volunteers. The main goal of the project is to promote multicultural actions and to give possibilities to volunteers to learn how to motivate the youth. Volunteers can share things about their cultural background and initiate intercultural conversations.

During the volunteering time the volunteers have to organize their own language conversation club at the local library (Méliusz Library) and english conversation club, Open Café. It's possible to work with local international organizations. (For example Alliance France french international organization or Deutches Kulturforum). They have to promote ESC and Erasmus+ opportunities during summer festivals. For example Campus in Debrecen or PanyolaFeszt. Finally, they can teach their mother tongue in local schools





# Project description

Through volunteering, we would like to show that different cultures can also be a valuable part of the society and the experience can be prosperous for the local community.

We believe that in this way we can motivate Hungarian youngsters to spend more time of their spare time with the volunteering.

The knowledge of the volunteers and the materials they prepared can be used to encourage the youngsters to take an active role and spend their free time effectively.

Through the volunteers, youngsters living in Hungary will have a chance to meet and get to know other cultures which will make them more open.
